Aerial Work Platforms - There are many accessories for lift trucks which can be used so as to help expand the capabilities of your lift truck and allow you to carry things, handle materials with less effort or to complete clean-up jobs.

Several of the attachments are specifically designed in order to fit on the blades themselves. Blade extensions for example, are used if you need a lot more fork length, that increases lifting capability. Blade extensions come in lengths ranging from forty eight to one hundred twenty inches. Triangular or rounded attachments are another type utilized when transferring rolled material to be able to make sure it does not roll off of the traditional flat forks.

Lifting accessories can be pivoting and telescoping crane attachments. They are available in many kinds. These attachments are usually designed for transferring poles, lumber, metal bars or any kind of bulky stuff. Other attachments such as different kinds of hooks and hook plates are offered to be able to carry things using a sling or chain. Slab filters and magnetic filters are other items which can be utilized along with hook attachments. Slab lifters are specialized attachments that are meant for carrying various materials which are delivered in a slab or sheet format. Rug rams or carpet poles are other lifting tools that connect to your forklift to make transferring rolls of carpet a lot easier. The attachment connects onto the lift truck's forks and has a pole that goes through the middle of the carpet roll.

There are various kinds of forklift attachment designed for facility maintenance like for example snow blades. These industrial blades could be attached to front end loaders and designed for moving materials such as snow, dirt as well as mulch. Other popular cleanup accessories consist of standard sweepers and magnetic sweepers. Standard sweepers comprise a broom which the forklift forks connect onto for sweeping big spaces like factory floors, parking lots and warehouse. The magnetic sweeper is similar except that it has a magnetic plate rather than bristles. The magnetic sweeper is used in places where there is lots of metal debris such as on shop floors for example. Sweepers have widths up to sixty inches and this surface area makes clean up fast and effortless.

Material spreaders are other attachments used on forklifts. These spreaders are helpful for a variety of applications like spreading fertilizers, insecticides, seeds, ice melt, rock salt and pellets.

Another optional lifting accessory are work platforms. These can be used by lots of various businesses everyday. Platforms may vary in size from $36" \times 36"$ to up to $60" \times 60"$. A few models may be accessible and are capable of folding up and storing into a smaller place. Work platforms are designed to raise workers up to an overhead location making use of the forklift. Larger platform units have extra space for workers so as to bring tools and other necessary objects intended for the job. Normally work platforms are made of steel or ploy material.
